Fahad Ahmed earned our endorsement because his public record, questionnaire responses, and forum answers demonstrated consistent and clear alignment with all of our principles. He is a Valley Ranch resident, a small business owner, a former PNZ commissioner, and a community leader who demonstrated both the knowledge and the moral clarity this seat requires. We note that he is the first Muslim candidate Irving Muslims PAC has endorsed. His faith is not the basis for our support. What is immaterial to us are the religious beliefs a candidate personally professes. However, what is material is how clearly their public positions align with our publicly stated principles. On that measure, Fahad Ahmed earned this endorsement.

Dana Collins engaged seriously with our process, attended our forum, and demonstrated genuine respect for this community, and we appreciated that. However, his positions on harmful industries and moral courage in public life were not hedges but clear stances that did not meet our standard, and he declined to engage on First Amendment rights entirely. We encourage him to continue listening deeply to the concerns of Irving's Muslim residents as he engages in civic life.
